- 1. The Tennant Arms Hotel, Kilnsey, is now under new management by Mr. and Mrs. P.Duval.
- 2. Last year, the Hot and Cold water system was extended to most of the bedrooms. Mr. W.D.Roberts, our President and the owner of the property, tells me he intends to make other considerable structural improvements as time and circumstances permit.
- 3. Mr. and Mrs. Duval have not taken over the furnishings by any means as they stood and are making a serious attempt, in spite of many difficulties, to improve on previous standards upstairs.
- 4. On the few occasions I have been there, the catering is greatly improved and I have good reason to believe that Mrs. Duval is an excellent cook.
- 5. There is an obvious desire on the part of Mr. and Mrs. Duval to build up an altogether better class of trade and to extend to the Club Members a degree of welcome that has been felt by so many to have been lacking hitherto.
- 6. Worthy and desirable though this endeavour may be, it cuts both ways, and it cannot succeed unless it is met by a corresponding measure of appreciation and practical support from our Members.
