TO MEMBERS,

A Yorkshire District Fishery Trout Licence must be taken out, 2/6.

Rule 12 now provides that any fish taken, less than NINE inches in length, be returned to the River.

Members are requested on all occasions to call at the Headquarters of the Club, "Tennant Arms," Kilnsey, to secure their Beats. The draw will not be made until after the arrival of the first post. Members writing to Headkeeper, "Tennant Arms," Kilnsey, Nr. Skipton, will thus have the same chance as Members on the spot. (A slate is provided in the Clubroom for Members to record their Beats before starting).

The season opens Monday, 1st April, and closes 30th September, inclusive.
