It should be noted that our Headkeeper, J. S. Ingleby, will, by arrangement, advise Members when the waters are favourable.

Members are requested on all occasions to call at the Headquarters of the Club, "Tennant Arms," Kilnsey, to secure their Beats. The Draw will not be made until after the arrival of the first post. Members writing to Headkeeper, "Tennant Arms," Kilnsey, Nr. Skipton, will thus have the same chance as Members on the spot. (A slate is provided in the Clubroom for Members to record their Beats before starting.)

The season opens on Friday, 1st April, and closes on September 30th, inclusive.

Extract from Minutes of Annual Meeting, 5/3/49.

Sunday Fishing.

It was proposed by Mr.B.Henderson, and seconded by Mr.A.Welch, that Sunday Fishing be allowed to members only.

After a long discussion, unanimous agreement was reached on the following lines:-

- (1) That such a major change of policy should not be made without all members being consulted, with a view to ascertaining whether there was a sufficient consensus of opinion in favour of such a step.
- (2) Without prejudice to the larger issue, Mr.Henderson's modified and limited suggestion that he should throw open, to members only, two beats on his own length of water each Sunday during the 1949 season, was adopted. This would shew the extent of the interest of the members in the project.
It was recognised that if there were a general disposition in favour of Sunday Fishing, the scheme could not be embarked upon without the prior approval and agreement of the various riparian owners from whom the Club rented fishing.
- (3) The modus operandi is that these beats shall be allocated by J.Ingleby at 9 a.m. at the Tennant Arms each Saturday morning for the next day. Members wishing to fish may notify him at any time in the same week either by 'phone, telegram, letter, or in person.
- (4) In the event of the issue being oversubscribed, J.Ingleby to allocate the available beats either by drawing lots or any other method so long as it ensures a fair distribution over the period to members desiring same.
